The General Election Day will be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2011 from 6:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. District 1 voters should report to the "Boy Scout Room" and Districts 2 & 3 to the "Senior Room", located in the lower level of Town Hall. The deadline to register to vote is: Tuesday, October 18, 2011 and Town Hall is open from 8:00 until 5:00 p.m. An individual may register to vote as long as they will turn 18 years of age by the General Election Day.

Chipping date in the month of:

September 21st
October 19th
November 16h
December 21st

Place chipping curbside no sooner than:

August 13th
September 17th
October 15th
November 12
December 17th

FROM THE TAX COLLECTORS OFFICE

The deadline to file for the Property Tax Reimbursement (Senior Freeze) with the State of New Jersey has been extended to October 31, 2011.

Requirements: NJ resident before 1/1/2000; resident in your current home before 1/1/2007; Age 65 before 12/31/2009; Income less than \$80,000 for 2009 and 2010; Increase in taxes between 2009 & 2010; Prior year taxes paid.
