PRESENTATION BY MIDDLESEX COUNTY DEPARTMENT ON AGING

Peg Chester of the Middlesex County Department on Aging presented a PowerPoint presentation on County services available to seniors. Highlights of Peg's discussion are as follows:

- A representative from Middlesex County can come to the Township monthly to meet with seniors on an individual basis.
- Steve Fittante of the Middlesex County Department of Transportation should be contacted for help in creating/establishing transportation services for seniors.
- Stephanie Fitzsimmons of St. Peters Hospital could be contacted for information on medical services and/or speakers.
- Elaine Flynn, Middlesex County Clerk, is the contact for senior photo IDs.
- Kevin Hoagland, County Surrogate, would be available to speak on estates and living wills.
- The Department of Health does nutritional counseling and breast cancer awareness seminars for seniors.
- Area Wide Transportation will transport groups at a nominal fee.

WORK SESSION

Meeting Date - Beginning in September, the Human Services Board will meet on the second Wednesday of the month. The Secretary will notify the necessary parties of the date change.

Cranbury Day - A table will be set up on Cranbury Day. Information to be handed out will include the 2006 Resource Directory, Middlesex County brochures, the Human Services Directory and the File of Life magnetic refrigerator pouches. Volunteers will be needed to man the table.

Human Services Directory – John and Rosemary will forward their sections to Kristen, who will compile a draft for review.

Photo IDs – Rosemary will contact Elaine Flynn to inquire if photo ids could be done on November 21, 2006, to coincide with a seniors meeting to be held at the Presbyterian Church.

DISCUSSION

A discussion was had whether some services could be shared with Four Seasons. It was decided that the Human Services Board should meet with the Board of Directors at Four Seasons. Joe will inquire.
