

RECYCLE SHED and E-WASTE RECYCLING for CRANBURY RESIDENTS

The Recycle Shed is located at the DPW Yard, 100 Dey Road. It is open on the first Friday of the month, from 9:00 am to 12:00 noon. If the first Friday is a legal holiday, then the Recycle Shed will be open on the Second Friday of the month.

Acceptable e-waste items at the Recycle Shed include:

CABLES/WIRES (extension cords/string lights)

CONTROLLERS (gaming)

E-READERS

KEYBOARDS

PRINTERS/FAX MACHINES

TELEPHONES (office, cell, home)

VIDEO EQUIPMENT (including remotes)

FLOURESCENT & SPOTLIGHT BULBS (CFLs & Tube bulbs up to 8'L)

COMPUTERS

DESKTOPS

COPIERS

FAX MACHINES

LAPTOPS

SCANNERS

TELEVISIONS

Please adhere to the above list. The authorized recycle vendor will charge an additional per pound fee for any items not on the above list **AND** for items packed in original cartons. To avoid additional charges, avoid bringing items in with packing material.

Clean formed polystyrene (EPS) will be accepted during open hours. White (only white), clean (tape & address labels removed) can be accepted. Packing peanuts and food/cup products are not acceptable. Clean packing peanuts may be brought to any UPS or Pak Mail location (<https://www.ups.com/us/en/Home.page> or <https://www.pakmail.com/>).

Scrap metal that can be recycled and made into other products (or other ferrous metals) **do not** belong in the trash destined for the landfill. Scrap metal includes bikes, metal/aluminum lawn furniture, metal fence posts, curtain rods, metal bed frames; as well as white goods such as washers, dryers, refrigerators, window a/c units, dehumidifiers, etc.

Freon Gas: State law mandates that appliances containing Freon gas **must be** extracted. Cranbury Township hires a responsible vendor to extract Freon containing appliances. Please do not leave any items at the Shed when it is not open. Items must be stored inside and kept out of the elements. Also, the wind will easily carry these lightweight items to parts unknown.

Acceptable e-waste and scrap metal items can be scheduled for pick-up service with the White Goods program. There is a fee of \$10 per item. Pick-up service is scheduled for the Second Wednesday of the month and arrangements must be made the Monday prior to this day. Please call 609-664-3130 to make arrangements.
