**OLD BUSINESS**

Drug Free Fair – May 8, 2010 – Jane Holland thanked the Student Representatives for helping at the Teen Tent. It was noted that there were numerous t-shirts left over and two (2) pair of drunk goggles were missing.

After much discussion, the following comments were made:

- The Municipal Alliance, as co-sponsor of the Drug Free Fair, should have more say on decisions involving the Fair, including the t-shirt contest.

- Fay Kobland, who worked at the Parent Tent, feels that statistics should be provided.
- Possibly change the “Parent Tent” to a “Parent Lounge” where parents can sit and relax while their children are enjoying the Fair.
- Changing the Fair to a later time (3pm – 6pm) would allow the children who are involved in sports to participate.
- Find a way for Cranbury School students who cannot attend the Fair to still be able to receive a t-shirt.

Middle School Picnic – The picnic has been rescheduled for Friday, June 11, 2010, from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. A list of rules will need to be prepared and distributed to the students. The Secretary will solicit volunteers via e-mail. There will be a DJ and food. Rather than purchasing canned sodas and bottled water, lemonade and water will be made in large coolers. The Student Representatives will inquire if the students would like organized games. Cranbury Pizza gift certificates and Happy Bunny items will be given as door prizes.
