

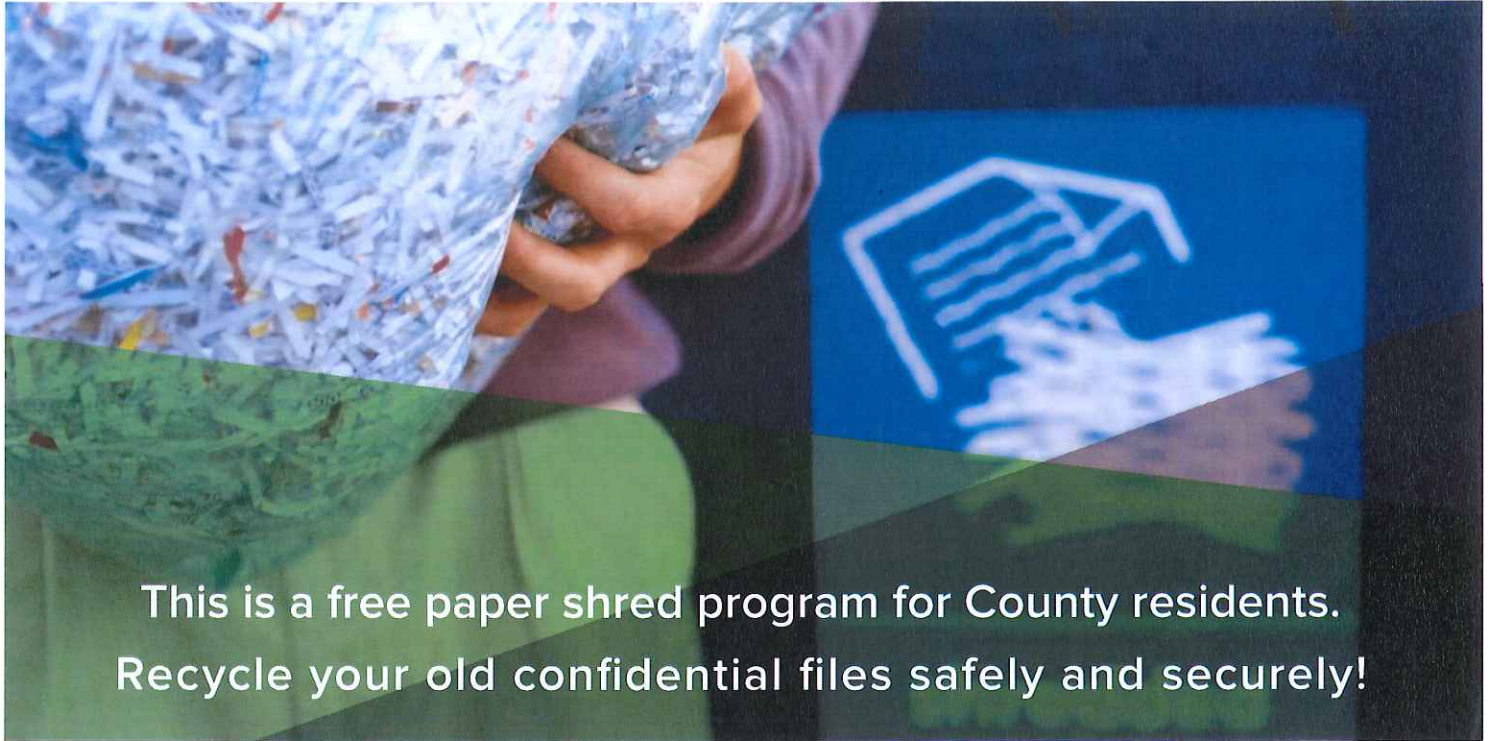
# RESIDENTIAL PAPER SHRED PROGRAM
