

## **CLEAN-UP WEEKEND & EWASTE COLLECTION September 30<sup>th</sup> & October 1st**

Clean-up weekend for Cranbury residents is September 30th and October 1st. Bring your unwanted items to the DPW Yard at 100 Dey Road; the hours of operation will be 9:00 am to 3:00 pm, rain or shine. The DPW crew will be on site to help unload your unwanted discards.

Acceptable materials include household items that are too large to fit inside your trash tote. If you are uncertain if an item is acceptable, please call Town Hall at 609-664-3129 to ask.

NO household trash, paint or hazardous waste items will be accepted. Please do not be sneaky and leave hazardous waste items at the DPW site for personnel to find. The Middlesex County has free collection programs for these items.

This service is open to Cranbury residents only. Be prepared to show proof of residency, such as a tax bill or driver license. Your driver's license may state 'Cranbury, NJ' but it is not necessarily Cranbury Township where you reside. View your tax bill; this will indicate what municipality you live in.

E-waste will be collected during this time. Polystyrene will not be collected at this time. Acceptable e-waste items (see below list), fluorescent bulbs (compact bulbs and tube bulbs no longer than 3').

### **Acceptable e-waste items include:**

APC/UPS (battery backup & power supply)	CABLES/WIRING (extension cords/string lights)
CONTROLLERS	COPIERS
E-READERS	KEYBOARDS
LAPTOPS	MAINFRAME/SERVERS
PRINTERS/FAX	SCANNERS
STEREOS	TELEPHONES (office, cell, home)
TONER CARTRIDGES	TELEVISIONS
TYPWRITERS	VIDEO EQUIPMENT

**Residents, please adhere to this list.** Do not bring items that are not on this list. The recycle vendor charges a collection per pound to remove and recycle many of these items. Due to the cost of this program, this service is available for Cranbury residents only. Be prepared to show ID!
