Cranbury Residents:

Since the Fall 2013 Newsletter was released, I have received several calls about recreational fires.

A recreational fire is considered a small fire that is contained in a fire pit (similar to ones that can be purchased at Home Depot or Lowes) and is only on private property.

A fire not contained in a fire pit is considered a bon fire and requires a permit not only from Cranbury's Fire Safety Bureau but also from the State Forest Fire Service.

Boy Scouts or Girl Scouts having small recreational fires on the West Property or in Village Park must obtain a Fire Safety Permit

Construction materials may not be burned. Please limit the materials in a fire to tree branches, twigs, etc.
