

REAPPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 11-11-21

ORDINANCE REAPPROPRIATING \$11,000.00 PROCEEDS OF OBLIGATIONS NOT NEEDED FOR THEIR ORIGINAL PURPOSES IN VARIOUS CAPITAL ORDINANCES IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF CRANBURY, IN THE COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX, NEW JERSEY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CRANBURY, IN THE COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to N.J.S.A.40A:2-39, it is hereby determined that the following proceeds of obligations originally made available pursuant to the bond ordinance listed below are no longer necessary for the following purpose:

Section 2. pursuant to N.J.S.A.40A:2.39, it is hereby determined that \$11,000.00 of the proceeds of obligations referred to above are hereby reappropriated to provide for the Fire Brush Truck Ordinance No. 11-11-20.

Section 3. The capital budget of the Township of Cranbury is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.

This Ordinance was introduced on First Reading on November 14, 2011 at a meeting of the governing body of the Township of Cranbury, in the County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey. It will be further considered for final passage, after public hearing thereon, at a regular meeting of the Township Committee to be held on Monday, November 28, 2011 at 7:00 p.m. Copies are available at no charge up to and including the week of Second Reading at the Clerk's Office or by accessing the Township web site at: cranburytownship.org.
