

TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE MEETING
JANUARY 31, 2005

A special budget meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Cranbury was held at 5:15 p.m. in the Township Administrator's Office. Answering present to the roll call were: Township Committee members: Thomas Panconi, Jr., Pari Stave, Richard Stannard, David J. Stout and Mayor Beauregard. Also present were: Frederick C. Carr, Administrator and Denise Marabello. Mayor Beauregard led in the salute to the flag and Mr. Carr gave following Open Public Meetings Act statement:

The Township Committee members were given an overview of the proposed 2005 Budget by Mr. Carr and Ms. Marabello and then had a general discussion.

The Township Committee agreed to meet again to discuss the budget on February 3, 2005 at 5:00 p.m.
