

Township Code requires that all cat owners present proof of rabies vaccination before a license can be issued.

- Rabies vaccination must be valid through October 31, 2024. (Pursuant to Township Code: Cat to be licensed and registered must have rabies vaccine having duration of immunity which extends throughout at least 10 of the 12 months of licensing period. Cats with duration of immunity against rabies that expires prior to the tenth month of licensing period shall be revaccinated prior to issuance of a license.)
- If applying by mail, please enclose a copy of the proper certificates (rabies vaccination and spay/neuter, if applicable) along with a self-addressed, stamped envelope.

<u>Penalties and Violations</u> - Licenses not obtained by March 1st will receive a first offense violation summons from the Board of Health Officer with a fine of \$50.00. Licenses not obtained by April 1st will receive a second offense violation summons from the Board of Health Officer with a mandatory court appearance and a fine of not less than \$75.00 or more than \$150.00.
