**ORDINANCE NO. 04-20-04**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CRANBURY, IN MIDDLESEX COUNTY,  
NEW JERSEY, AMENDING CHAPTER 143 ENTITLED “VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC”**

WHEREAS, Chapter 143 of the Code of the Township of Cranbury (“Code”) addresses vehicular and traffic issues within the Township; and

WHEREAS, 143-7 Turn Prohibitions of this chapter addresses the turn and movement prohibitions at certain intersections in the Township; and

WHEREAS, the township wishes to add a no right turn on red from Hightstown-Cranbury-Station Road onto Station Road;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Cranbury, Middlesex County, New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. The recitals contained in the foregoing preamble are incorporated herein as if fully restated.

Section 143-7 of the Code of the Township of Cranbury (“Code”), entitled “Turn prohibitions,” is hereby amended and shall read as follows (additions are underlined; deletions are in [brackets]):

**§ 143-7. Turn prohibitions.**

<b>Intersection</b>	<b>Turn Prohibited</b>	<b>Movement Prohibited</b>
Hightstown-Cranbury-Station Rd and Station Road	Right on Red	From Hightstown-Cranbury- Station Rd onto Station Road

SECTION 2. Repealer. All ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, inconsistent with this Ordinance, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication, as required by law.

The ordinance published herewith was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the governing body of the Township of Cranbury, in the County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey, held on April 13, 2020, 2019. It will be further considered for final passage, after public hearing thereon, at a meeting of the governing body to be

held in the meeting room of Town Hall, 23-A North Main Street, in the Township of Cranbury on April 27, 2020 at 7:00 P.M., and during the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's Office to the members of the general public who shall request the same .
