ORDINANCE NO. 01-19-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CRANBURY, IN MIDDLESEX COUNTY, NEW JERSEY, AMENDING CHAPTER 167 ENTITLED "SMOKING PROHIBITED IN TOWNSHIP PARKS, OPEN SPACE AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES"

WHEREAS, Chapter 167 of the code of the Township of Cranbury ("Code") prohibits smoking in Township parks, open space and recreational facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health recognizes that it is in the public interest to expand the area where smoking would be prohibited; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that enforcement by the Police Department is necessary to ensure compliance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Health of the Township of Cranbury, Middlesex County, New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. The recitals contained in the foregoing preamble are incorporated herein as if fully restated.

Section 167 of the code of the Township of Cranbury ("Code"), entitled "Smoking Prohibited in Township Parks, Open Space and Recreational Facilities" is hereby amended and shall read as follows (additions are <u>underlined</u>; deletions are in [brackets]:

§ 167-2. Smoking in certain public places prohibited; signs required.

A. Smoking shall be prohibited in Millstone Park, Heritage Park, Village Park, <u>Barn Park</u>, <u>Cranbury Brook Preserve (West Property)</u>, <u>Hagerty Park</u>, <u>Memorial Park</u>, <u>Brainerd Dam</u>, <u>Reinhardt Forest Preserve</u>, <u>Shadow Oaks Park</u>, <u>Unami Woods</u>, <u>West Fields and all other</u> <u>Township-owned properties</u>.

§ 167.3. Enforcement

[The Health Officer or Board of Health] <u>The Police Department</u> shall enforce this article.

SECTION 2. Repealer. All ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, inconsistent with this Ordinance, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section,

paragraph, subsection, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication, as required by law.

The Ordinance published herewith was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the Board of Health of the Township of Cranbury, in the County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey, held on January 14, 2019. It will be further considered for final passage, after public hearing thereon, at a meeting of the Board of Health to be held in Town Hall, 23-A North Main Street, in the Township of Cranbury on February 4, 2019 at 7:00 p.m., and during the week prior and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of said Ordinance will be made available at the Clerk's Office to the members of the general public who shall request the same.
