FUNCTION:

Memorial Park is a small, landscaped park located adjacent to the Cranbury Firehouse on Main Street and across the street from Brainerd Dam and Brainerd Lake. A monument and flagpole (the Cranbury Memorial Veterans' Monument), honoring the servicemen and women from World War II through Vietnam, is located in the park's center. Benches, seating areas and tended flowerbeds are arranged around the monument. Historical markers on the site of the former Old Grist Mill are also located in the park.
