Cranbury Township has arranged to have all Township roads swept. Weather permitting, the entire Township will be swept Monday, August 31^{st} through September 2^{nd} . The downtown area will be swept on Tuesday, September 1^{st} during the early hours of 6am and 11am.

Please avoid parking on the below listed streets on September 1st, between 6am and 11am. Doing so will allow the sweeper to easily and expediently sweep the streets. Once the streets have been swept, parking will be allowed.

AVOID PARKING ON:

Maplewood Avenue North Main Street Park Place (East and West)

Scott Avenue South Main Street Westminster Place

Between the hours of 6am and 11am on September 1st

For the street sweeper to be thorough, please remove personal items and or vehicles from the streets. Place your trash can up on the sidewalk, not in the street. Three available lots are available for overnight parking to help avoid parking on the above streets for an early morning sweep. Municipal lots are located on Park Place West (in front of the senior complex); four off-street parking spots near the entrance of the Cranbury Brook Preserve; public lots located behind Sweetwater Construction and Village Park has two available lots available for overnight parking. Parking is on a first come basis. It is realized that the sweeping may pose an inconvenience but your cooperation in keeping vehicles and personal property off the streets during this time is greatly appreciated.

Brush/chipping will begin August 19th. Kindly refrain from placing brush/chipping at the curb after August 19th. Please remove any leaf piles at the curb, if left, they will be swept around. Your cooperation will help keep the streetscape beautiful and is greatly appreciated!
