- Filed at the Cranbury Town Hall
- Posted on the Township's website; and
- Sent to those individuals who have requested personal notice.

Because of the rapid and unexpected spread of the virus, the need for this meeting could not reasonably have been foreseen at a time when adequate notice could have been provided.

WHEREAS, this special meeting shall be limited to discussion of and acting with respect to matters involving the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, notice of this special meeting is being provided as soon as possible following the calling of the meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee could not reasonably have foreseen the need for this special meeting at a time when adequate notice could have been provided.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Cranbury, County of Middlesex, upon the affirmative vote of three quarters of the members present, that the requirements of the Cranbury Township Code and the Open Public Meetings Act for holding a special meeting without adequate notice have been satisfied; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this special meeting shall be limited to discussion of and acting with respect to matters involving the COVID-19 pandemic.
